# Mandeville Canyon Road Speed Tables

As you may have read or noticed, the 90-120 day cooperative program of awareness, education, and enforcement began last month. If this program does not result in the critical speed on Mandeville being lowered to 34 miles per hour or less, the speed tables will be installed. Worth noting is that if the speed tables themselves don't lower the critical speed to 34 miles per hour or less they will be removed.

The bottom line: during the summer months we will be voting for or against speed tables with our gas pedals, so please be aware of your speed in the canyon.
